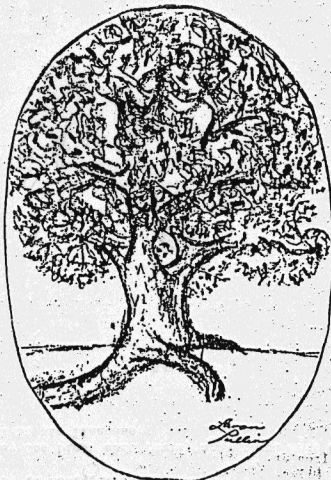

History of the Pullen Family

Families are like trees. If the roots are properly nourished they will not die. The seedlings will survive and grow to maturity, producing branches strong in greatness and prosperity. We are the branches of the Pullen tree.

Great-great grandfather, Rev. Ezekiel Pullen (Aug. 21, 1816 - Oct. 14, 1888) was the oldest known relative of the Pullen family. The name of his wife is unknown. Rev. Pullen was one of the founders of Mt. Pullen A.M.E. Methodist Church. The church was founded in 1862 and is located eight miles from Dublin, Ga. In 1972, the original structure was replaced by a new church bearing the former name.

The only known child of Ezekiel Pullen is a son, Milton (Bunk) Pullen. Milton married our grandmother, Lula. To that union seven children were born: Arthur B., Willie Oscar, Milton Jr., Martha, Lucy, Alzada and Ada.

Martha married James McClain. They had no children. Lucy was married to Let Clark. To that union two daughters were born, Mattie Maude and Estella. Ada married Leroy Groover. They had one daughter, Vera Mae. Arthur (Bubba) was married to Jane Hason. To that union six children were born: Joeste, Raymond, Alma, Armetta, Anteen and Maxine.

Milton Jr. married Eva. Two sons were born to that union: Milton III and Booker Tee. Willie Oscar (Hun) Pullen married Donnie Hason. From that union came four sons and six daughters: Charlie Willie, Quincy, Johnny Louis, Maggie Nadine, Sarah Lou, Ruby Dell, Fritella and Lavera. All of the children of Milton Pullen are deceased.
